



## Age Divisions for 2012

### **Cubs- Athletes Born in the year 1999 or since 1999**

An athlete may compete in the Cub class in tournaments until December 31 of the year of his or her 13<sup>th</sup> birthday.

### **Intermediate – Athletes born in the years 1997 or 1998**

An athlete may compete in the Intermediate class in tournaments until December 31 of the year of his or her 15<sup>th</sup> birthday.

### **Cadets- Athletes born in the year 1995 or 1996**

An athlete may compete in the Cadet class in tournaments until December 31 of the year of his or her 17<sup>th</sup> birthday.

### **20 and Under (Junior)- Athletes born in the years 1992, 1993 or 1994**

An athlete may compete in the 20 and Under class in tournaments until December 31 of the year of his or her 20<sup>th</sup> birthday.

### **Open - Athletes born in the year 1963 to 1991 inclusive**

Any athlete of any age may compete in the Open class in tournaments, however those born in the above years can only compete in the Open class.

### **Masters- Athletes born in the year 1953 to 1962**

An athlete may compete in the Master class in tournaments from January 1 of the year of his her 50<sup>th</sup> birthday and thereafter.

### **Veterans- Athletes born in the year 1952 or prior to 1952**

An athlete may compete in the Veteran class in tournaments from January 1 of the year of his her 60<sup>th</sup> birthday and thereafter.

Please note that:

**Anyone** can shoot in the Open class;

**Veterans** can shoot as a Master;

**Cadets** can shoot as a 20 & Under;

**Intermediates** can shoot as a Cadet or 20 & Under;

**Cubs** can shot as an Intermediate, Cadet or 20 & Under

Clubs may develop younger or older age divisions to cater for their own needs. The age divisions above are the only age divisions recognised for Archery WA State Records, Archery Australia National Records and State, National and Youth National Championships. For all AWA record claims please refer to the State Records Policy
